## 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> GRADE TESTING

### BEGINS THIS WEEK



Beginning Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup> through Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup> all 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade students at Mariposa will take the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) tests as required by the State of California. May 13<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> is English Language Arts and May 20<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> is Math. This is an important measure of how well our students are learning the California Common Core Standards.

Mariposa teachers and support personnel have worked all year on the standards your child needs to know to do well on this important test. Working with your children at home has contributed greatly to their success. Thank you for the many hours you spend each week helping them with their homework and projects. The partnership between home and school is one of the cornerstones to our school's success.

Mariposa students have always historically excelled on these assessments. We are confident this year will be no different and, as usual, we need your help at home during this testing period:



It is important that your child is at school every day during the next two weeks. Make-up tests are often disruptive to on-going class work



Make sure your child is at school on time.



Make sure your child has a good, hearty breakfast with lots of protein and carbohydrates. Brain food means good thinking!



Make sure your child gets plenty of rest the night before each test.



Do whatever you can to avoid morning stresses during testing. Arriving at school on time will help your child start the day positively.



Remind your child to use their best testing strategies and not to rush through the tests. The CAASPP tests are not timed!
