### Hybrid Return to School - Spring 2021 "Reference Sheet"

- All students and staff are required to wear a face covering at all times while on campus.
- Hand sanitizer and extra masks will be readily available for all persons on campus.
- All students will be assigned a specific Entry/Exit gate.
- All students and staff are screened with health questions and a temperature check before entering campus.
- Student desks are equipped with “see-thru” plastic shielding on their desk.
- Students are spaced 6 feet apart within the classroom.
- There will be not more than 14 students in the classroom during each session.
- Classrooms will be disinfected by custodial staff between sessions daily.
- Students will have their own set of supplies and materials to use in class. They will not be shared with others.
- Restrooms will be monitored for reduced capacity and consistently sanitized.
- Students may need to bring their school supplies and tools to and from school – this may include their laptop and charging cable.
- A Grab-n-Go lunch will be sent home with each student at the end of their session.
- The district-wide grab-n-go for a week’s worth of meals (24) will be available for pickup on Wednesdays, beginning April 7<sup>th</sup>, at the district pick-up locations.
- Students will be assigned to the AM or PM schedule – preferences may not be able to be met.
- All siblings and students from the same household will be in the same session.
- Students remaining on Distance Learning may have their daily schedule **changed** to match those of their in person peers.
- There is no recess built into the daily learning schedule, however teachers may utilize outdoor space for learning. Outdoor equipment will be cleaned and sanitized.
- Every effort will be made to keep students with their current teacher. However, this may not be possible regardless of which learning model is chosen.
