The information in this letter is very important and explains a big change that will soon take place at our school. Starting Monday, October 1st, students will enter the campus on their own and walk themselves onto school. Parents, families and volunteers who want to walk onto the campus will need to check in at the office prior to coming on the school grounds. These new procedures will apply before, during and after school hours.

This upcoming change to our school procedures has been widely shared at our Pastry with the Principal meetings as well as at the Community Meeting held on September 17, 2018. While inconvenient, this change is necessary to secure our campus and protect our students from potentially dangerous situations and/or people.

If you would like to see your child's teacher outside of the school day, please make an appointment prior to coming. On the day of your visit, you will need to provide some type of government identification that will be scanned by our Raptor system. Once you receive a Raptor visitor's badge, you will gain access to the school and teacher's classroom.

Parent involvement is a critical factor to children's academic success. Now more than ever, your help and support is greatly needed. Please consider volunteering in your student's class or chaperoning a field trip. There are volunteer packets in our office and you can pick one up at any time.
