<u>Welcome Back to our students who have returned to campus this week!</u> We are excited to have our students back with us at Cope and for some of you, this will be your first time on our campus. <u>COVID Safety</u>: Students please remember that while you are on campus, all COVID safety protocols are in effect. You must be masked and must maintain 6 feet between you and another person when out on campus. In the classroom, masks also must be worn and you are to stay at your desk behind the plexiglass barriers, 3 feet or more away from your classmates. Information for 8th into 9th Grade Summer School — Summer School Courses for Incoming 9th Graders Redlands High School Summer 2021 Freshman Ready Math Course (one semester/session) The course targets students who struggled with math in 8th grade. It is designed to prepare incoming 9th graders for Integrated Math I. **It is highly recommended to take this class in person on the RHS campus. English Language Development (one or two semesters/sessions) This course targets the development of the English language for students whose first language is not English. It is designed to help EL students be successful in their core classes in 9th grade, with an emphasis in reading, vocabulary, and writing. **It is highly recommended to take this class in person on the RHS campus. Study Skills (one or two semesters/sessions) This course targets students in the mild-moderate programs (RSP/SDC). It is designed to help orient students to the RHS campus and learn the skills they need to succeed as they prepare for 9th grade. Some topics include general academics, SEL, and orientation to the RHS campus. *This class will be offered on campus only.
