

## **RUSD Athletic Spectator Guidelines**

Per discussions amongst CBL site administrators and athletic directors, the following guidelines for football competition have been established, in observation of the CDPH Youth Sports Guidelines (dated December 14, 2020) and the CIF-SS Update on All Sports Guidelines for Competition (dated January 25, 2021).

**Stadium Seating:** Fans will sit in family units of no more than **four** people. Stadium benches will be sectioned off into seating segments that will have six foot clearance in between. All family units must sit in designated bleacher sections. All fans must remain in their seats, unless using the restroom facilities. Masks must be worn at all times.

**Food:** No food items will be allowed in the facilities. SEALED water bottles will be allowed. No hydro flask/refillable bottles will be allowed. At this time, concession stands are not allowed.

### **Masks and Sanitation:**

- **Players:** Masks will be worn by all players when they are **not** on the field of play. This includes the sidelines and pregame, halftime, and post-game activities.
- **Spectators:** Masks will be worn at all times. Hand sanitizer will be available in several areas throughout the facilities. The restrooms will be sanitized on a regular basis throughout the event
- Restrooms are limited to no more than 2 guests at a time. Thank you for your patience.

**Gates/Arrival:** All family units must arrive together. The football gate opens at 3:30. No mask, no entry. Football tickets must be purchased through the Go Fan app.

**Water Bottles:** Team members shall not share water bottles. Athletes must bring their own water.
