



## RHS Summer School 2023 Information

Important information for grades 9-12

### **General Information**

Summer School classes for Redlands High School students will be held **in person** at Redlands High School. Summer School is divided into two sessions. Students can earn five credits per session, for a total of up to ten credits. **First session Edgenuity courses must be completed by 1:00 pm on July 5th in order to start a second course. Any Edgenuity student who does not complete their course by 1:00pm on July 21th will be required to retake the course, no exceptions.** All courses, including Edgenuity courses, will be held in person, on the RHS campus.

### **Credit Advancement Registration**

Online registration will open April 3, 2023 at 5:00 pm and close at 3:00 pm April 14, 2023. ### **Credit Recovery Registration**

Credit Recovery registration is completed through your counselor. Please make an appointment to see your counselor before school, at lunch, or after school to discuss recovering grades and attending summer school. *Information will be emailed in June confirming enrollment.*

### **Attendance**

Attendance is extremely important in these condensed sessions. Students will be allowed to miss a maximum of six (6) hours per session, regardless of the reason. *A tardy constitutes a loss of one hour of attendance.* Students accumulating more than six (6) hours of absences due to full period absences and/or tardies will be dropped from class. *Students are required to attend the first day of class or they will be dropped.*

### **Behavior**

Behavioral expectations required during the traditional academic year remain in effect during summer school and students who do not meet those expectations will be dropped from the summer school program.

### **Academic Requirements**

Courses are academically rigorous. Students should be prepared to devote a significant amount of time both in and out of class. All classes must be completed at the end of summer school, no exceptions.

### **Nutrition**

A no cost breakfast will be provided before school, students will have a no cost nutrition break mid-day, and a no cost lunch will be provided after school.
