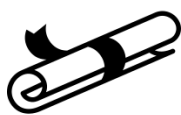
**San Bernardino Community College District** will offer these students:

- 1--Two years of **zero** tuition.
- 2--Students will receive priority course enrollment.
- 3--\$600 annual textbook stipend.
- 4--\$200 annual cash aid to cover costs like transportation.
- 5--Free access to a laptop rental for coursework.
- 6--Individualized college and career advising so you can earn a career certificate, an associate's degree, or transfer to a four-year university in two years.

## **How do I sign up? It starts March 8---Don't wait!**
