

Freshman Calendar – CVHS 2020-2021

August:

- Sign up for CVHS Google classroom so you don't miss out on college/career updates.
Code is: **2lptpgr**
- Take challenging courses in accordance with a-g requirements.
- Maintain as high a GPA as possible. **MAKE NO GRADE LOWER THAN C!**
- If you don't already have one, apply for a social security card.
- Participate in extracurricular activities, clubs, athletics, and/or other organizations (see Daily Bulletin and counselors' list). College admissions counselors strongly encourage involvement and leadership in extracurricular activities.

September:

- Attend your school's counselor presentation on 4-year planning and success in high school.
- Create your four-year plan
- Sign up for a tutor in the Career Center or Counseling Office (depends on which school you attend) if you begin to struggle in one or more courses! Visit the library during lunch to work with peer tutors.
- As recommended by your counselor, create your "involvement chart" that will continue through grade 12. Be sure to include:
 - √ School Activities
 - √ Community Activities
 - √ Volunteer Activities

October:

- Participate in College Month activities. All will be posted on Google Classroom
- Attend the RUSD Virtual College Events from September – November at <http://bit.ly/RUSDCollege2020> This is also in Google Classroom and updated DAILY so check it often. ☺
- Start a College file to keep information about Colleges that interest you.

November:

- Qualify for semester academic excellence awards.

December:

- Prepare thoroughly and do a good job on semester finals: **December 15th- 17th, 2020**
- Remember that these grades are used to determine which colleges will accept your applications!

January:

- Start second semester with a positive attitude and a good "SLANT"!
 - Sit up, Lean forward, Ask questions, Nod, Take notes

February/ March:

- Attend your school's counselor presentation on registering for your 10th grade courses.
- Attend events during Career Technical Education (CTE) week – especially the OPTIONS fair!
- Complete registration for 10th grade courses.
- Turn in volunteer time sheets to the Career Center before spring break.
- Visit the Career Center to explore career possibilities.

April/May:

- Make sure that you're ready for final exams in June. Remember, **GRADES COUNT!**
