BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

Under the direction of the school site principal and District Designated Administrator of the Expanded Learning Opportunity Programs (ELO-P), provide support for the ELO-P as determined by the district and school plan and State/Federal guidelines.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Coordinate school-wide testing and data reporting.
- Assist in the coordination of ELO-P certificated and classified staff.
- Maintain and operate resource labs where applicable.
- Plan meetings with certificated and classified staff.
- Provide school site trainings for ELO-P certificated and classified staff.
- Support the ELO-P through the selection and purchase of supplemental materials.
- Schedule coordinated instructional periods to support classroom programs.
- Attend conferences and disseminate information to school staff and site council.
- Assist with ongoing evaluation of school plan.
- Research and evaluate new educational delivery systems available.
- Provide counsel and assistance to classroom teachers, specifically for ELO-P, and others, to more effectively implement ELO-P.
- Provide assistance in placement of students in reading and math, as well as other learning levels and needs.
- Where applicable, assist and facilitate in the development of the following strategies: cross-age/peer tutoring, team teaching, and parent involvement.
- Provide in-classroom support where requested.
- Act as a liaison between the school and parents of students as needed.

- Act as a resource to disseminate information regarding parent education issues.
- Assist with providing intervention strategies for at-risk students.
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the school site principal and/or the District Designated Administrator of ELO-P.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS
