Input as CSU Expository Reading & Writing

- Applicants should enter only Math and Language Other than English course completed in 7th and 8th grades as grade levels and academic years, with their 9th grade high school selected (No UC CMP lists for Middle Schools)

- Applicants must enter all courses completed, In Progress or Planned to fulfill A-G subject requirements **Senior year 1st sem courses: In Progress**
Senior year 2nd sem courses: Planned
- Course type should be None when the course is not AP, IB or Honors
- Only UC CMP approved Honors courses will be granted the extra point
- Courses taken for less than a full year should be reported with the one grade earned and 'No Grade' selected for the opposite term **American Gov, Econ, etc.**
- Courses completed at a College should be reported on the College Transcript entry screen, and then manually matched to an A-G category **Dual Enrollment, Concurrent Enrollment, and Articulated Courses**
- Manually entered courses must be manually matched A-G category

Update A-G Courses

- Applicants must click on the Update A-G Courses button to review their entries, and ensure that all courses have an A-G area assigned
- Area G courses may be pulled from additional years completed in above A-F categories
- Based on the UC's revised Laboratory Science disciplines, applicants may need to manually revise the D1/D2 category

Ask for help if requirements are not met before submitting!!!

Validation: Math, Chemistry, or Lang Other Than English

A grade of C or higher in the second semester validates a D or F earned in the first semester • Enter the valid grades earned with a consecutive row with the same course title, and a grade of Pass for the first semester and select No Grade for the second semester.

Summer School Courses

Add a Summer Grade Level If you completed courses during the Summer, click on Add Summer Courses. If you took a summer class between 9th and 10th grade, the summer grade level should be set to 10th grade. Each Summer should be entered in individually by grade level

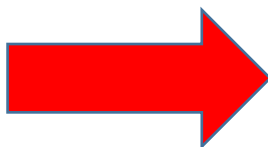
Repeated Courses

- CSU defines repeated courses as the exact same course with the exact same course title taken at the same school at a later time.
 - If you repeated a course, enter the highest grade(s) earned for the course. Do not enter this repeated course twice.
 - If the repeated course is planned or in progress, enter the original grade earned, as well as the planned or in progress course as a new grade has not yet been earned.
