General Information

Summer School classes for high school students will be provided through Distance Learning using the online Edgenuity program with asynchronous support.

The summer session will run for up to five weeks, depending on student ability to successfully complete the online course.

Dates and Times:

June 9 - July 17
Time: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
No school July 3rd in observance of Independence Day.

Registration: Students have already completed the registration process. By May 1, students will be notified of their registration status. Some courses for Credit Advancement have been eliminated due to the online format required for summer school 2020. Credit Advancement courses **offered** include World History, US History, US Govt, Economics, ELD, and Math II Honors Bridge. Science courses, PE and Art **have been eliminated from credit advancement**. No new registrations will be accepted apart from 2nd semester Credit Recovery needs.

- Economics
- World History
- US History

Academic Requirements

Competency-based classes in English, Math, Science and Social Studies are academically rigorous. Students enrolling in these classes should be prepared to devote a significant amount of time both in and out of class. Students are expected to attend tutorials if subject area competency is not achieved.
