General Information

Summer School classes for high school students will be provided through Distance Learning using the online Edgenuity program with asynchronous support.

The summer session will run for up to five weeks, depending on student ability to successfully complete the online course.

Dates and Times:

June 9 - July 17
Time: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
No school July 3rd in observance of Independence Day.

Registration: Most applications have already been submitted, however students were given a due date to submit their registrations for Credit/Grade Recovery to their Counseling Center by Friday, April 17, 2020, at 3:00 p.m. This date will be honored, but applications received after April 17, will be handled on a space availability basis. If no space is available, student names will be placed on a waitlist. By May 1, students will be notified of their registration status. No new registrations will be accepted apart from 2nd semester Credit Recovery needs.

Academic Requirements

Competency-based classes in English, Math, Science and Social Studies are academically rigorous. Students enrolling in these classes should be prepared to devote a significant amount of time both in and out of class. Students are expected to attend tutorials if subject area competency is not achieved.
