Dear Parent/Guardian,

Summer School for Credit Recovery and Credit Advancement will continue to be provided with limitations to the original credit advancement offerings for Redlands Unified School District high school students through a distance learning platform. Distance Learning will be offered through the use of an online program (Edgenuity) with teachers checking in with students and providing needed instructional support similarly to the way we are currently providing Distance Learning.

Registration for both Credit Recovery and Credit Advancement has already been completed, with the exception of any additional second semester needs for credit/grade recovery. Students who registered for Credit Advancement World History, United States History, US Government, Economics, Freshman Ready Math, Math II Honors Bridge, and ELD will maintain their current status (registered or waitlisted.) Biology, Chemistry, PE and Art Credit Advancement courses will **no longer be offered**. In addition, we will not be accepting any new credit advancement registrations. Students who are no longer able to complete a course they planned for have other options to pursue and are encouraged to reach out to their school counselors to ensure they are following the expectations outlined in RUSD Board Policy and Administrative Regulations 6146.11.

Additional information regarding our online summer school program will be provided electronically as we continue to progress towards the June 9 start date. Students will need to have a device with video, audio and internet support for the summer school course, as they should have currently.

Redlands Unified School District is committed to promoting student success through the offering of both rigorous and appropriate courses to meet each student's individual needs. Every effort will be made to differentiate our programs to meet this objective.
