

Notice of Virtual Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Bernardino County Committee on School District Organization ("County Committee") has called the following Public Hearing:

Proposal to transfer territory from Colton Joint Unified School District to Redlands Unified School District

The public is invited to attend and participate in this Public Hearing of the County Committee. At this Public Hearing, the public may submit public comments on the petition of the City of Loma Linda to transfer territory from Colton Joint Unified School District to Redlands Unified School District and redraw the school district boundaries of Redlands Unified School District and the Colton Joint Unified School District. The City of Loma Linda's City Council Resolution No. 3082 states in part that the Loma Linda City Council supports the proposition that **all residents of Loma Linda be part of the Redlands Unified School District**. The current school district boundaries bisect the City of Loma Linda.

Following the Public Hearing, the County Committee must grant or deny the petition. If the petition is granted, the County Committee must adopt a tentative recommendation (Education Code section 35721).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the County Committee will conduct its hearing under the provisions for virtual meetings of Assembly Bill (AB) 361. AB 361, until January 1, 2024, authorizes a local agency to use teleconferencing without complying with the teleconferencing requirements imposed by the Ralph M. Brown Act when a legislative body of a local agency holds a meeting during a declared state of emergency, as that term is defined, when state or local health officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, during a proclaimed state of emergency held for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, and during a proclaimed state of emergency when the legislative body has determined that meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, as provided. Such action is valid for 30 days and may be renewed at regular or special meetings as necessary.


