### **Assembly Bill (AB) No. 367 & 1732**

REDLANDS, Calif. – During the September 13, 2022 Redlands Unified School District Board of Education Meeting, Superintendent Mauricio Arellano reminded the community of the District’s responsibility of following [AB 367 Menstrual Products](#) and [AB 1732 Single-User Restrooms](#).

On October 8, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 367, Menstrual Products. This bill “requires public schools to distribute free menstrual products on campuses serving grades 6-12.” Starting the beginning of the 2022-23 school year, Redlands Unified will continue stock the school’s restrooms at all times with an adequate supply of menstrual products. If a school’s restroom is out of menstrual products, please contact the school’s administration. On March 1, 2017 Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 1732, Single-User Restrooms. This bill “requires all single-occupancy restrooms in business, government buildings, and places of accommodation to be available to everyone.” Redlands Unified transformed all single-user toilet facilities to be identified as all-gender toilet facilities by signage
