Daily Schedule:

- Lunch:
 - In-Person students will eat lunch outdoors and will be expected to maintain a distance of 6 feet from other students and/or staff.
 - Lunch will be grab-and-go style. All meals will be pre-packaged and shelf-stable.
 - There will be NO BREAKFAST provided at this time.
 - Grab-and-Go meals will continue to be provided on Wednesday mornings through Child Nutrition Services. These meals include breakfast and lunch for all students in the household.

Transportation:

All students that live more than 2.0 miles from Moore Middle School, and are within their home school boundaries, are eligible to receive transportation.

Bussing routes and schedules will be available on the RUSD website (<https://www.redlandsusd.net/Domain/63>) beginning Thursday, April 8.

Arrival / Dismissal:

We ask that parents remain in their vehicle and drop their children off curbside via accessible gates. Students will not be allowed on campus prior to 8:15 am.

Designated entries for student entry:

- GATE 1 - Bus Ramp center gate (for bus riders only)
- GATE 2: Parking lot corner gate (for students dropped off in parking lot or walking near admin building)
- GATE 4: Highland Avenue center gate
- GATE 6: 5th Avenue gate at stairs
- GATE 7: L-Wing Gate (at the Redlands Circle near Home of the Monarchs mural)

Personal vehicles will NOT be allowed to enter the bus ramp, as this is reserved for school busses only. Students who walk to school may enter through any of the gates listed above.

Upon entering campus, students will receive a health screening which consists of a temperature check as well as answering five health screening questions. Students are able to complete the health questionnaire prior to arriving at school. Directions for the pre-screening process are [here](#).

After their health screening, students will be asked to wait outside in designated areas for their classrooms to open.

Students will be dismissed at the end of the school day and directed to leave campus through one of the same gates open for arrival. Please make arrangements with your child so they know where to meet you if they are receiving a ride home. Students will not be allowed to remain on campus when school is over. To assist with crowding, please pick up your child immediately after school.

Safety Protocols:

Safety is of the utmost importance. In line with the RUSD Covid-19 School Safety Plan and the San Bernardino County of Public Health, the following layers of safety will be implemented at Moore Middle School.

- **Face Coverings** - All staff and students will be required to wear a face covering upon entering campus. Appropriate signage can be found throughout campus as a reminder.
- **Health Screening and Temperature Checks**
 - All students and staff members will complete a health screening and temperature check upon arrival. If a temperature registers above 100.4, one rescreening will take place and then the student or staff member will be sent home. (Students sent home are able to participate in classes virtually).
 - We ask that students and staff complete the [screening questionnaire](#) prior to arriving at school to expedite this process.



- **Social Distancing** - Social Distancing will be monitored in all classrooms and throughout campus. Floor markings and signage will be present on campus to assist in this process in high traffic areas.
- **Isolation Room** - Any student who is exhibiting signs of COVID-19 will be supported in a separate room in which they will be safe and comfortable while waiting to be picked up. This room will be monitored by a Health Clerk or other staff member, and will be disinfected regularly.
- All classrooms and restrooms will be routinely disinfected. Handwashing signs will be posted at sinks.

Technology/Instructional Materials:

- Students will be required to bring their district issued Chromebook to school each day. Students who do not have Chromebooks checked out to them may do so this week during our office hours of 7:30 am - 3:30 pm or on Monday morning upon arrival to school. ***Personal devices may not be used while on campus.***
- Please charge these devices each night for use the following school day.
- Students should bring paper and pencil, or other school supplies, to school with them each day. All students were offered a pencil pouch with supplies at the beginning of the school year.



Water Bottles:

- Water fountains will not be available for students to use to drink directly from the fountain. All water fountains will be used as filling stations only. Please have your child bring a water bottle to school each day. It is recommended that you label these with your child's name.



All school rules and expectations of positive behavior are expected to be followed. Please refer to the student handbook at the front of the Student Agenda.
