Required Documents: As part of your application, you must upload the following documents to Scholarship America by **3:00 p.m. CST on December 6, 2018 or until the first 700 applications are submitted, whichever comes first.**

A current, complete transcript of grades. Grade reports are not accepted. Transcripts must display student name, school name, grades and credit hours for each course and term in which each course was taken.

Copy of the first two pages of the most recently filed IRS Form 1040 used for the Financial Information Page.

Your application is not complete unless all required documents are submitted electronically.

Program Deadline Your application must be submitted on or before December 6, 2018 or until the first 700 applications are submitted, whichever comes first. Customer Service is available during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. CST. Only the first 700 applications submitted will be considered for scholarship evaluation
