STUDENT CENTER

1. Do you want to work in the Student Store? Are you looking for an exciting new elective to take next semester? Then see Mrs. Tygart in the Student Center, Mrs. Liggins in the Student Store, or your counselor to enroll in Career Planning and Management, a new semester-long elective being offered next semester! Students in this class will run the Student Store, explore various career fields, and work on employment skills such as job searching, interviewing, and more. Earn elective credits while preparing for your future career!
2. Do you need elective credits but don't have room in your schedule? You can earn 5 elective credits through Career Express Online, a free online CTE program! We offer online classes about careers in various fields, computer programming classes, and even a Medical Terminology class! See Mrs. Tygart in the Student Center to sign up. Last day to register is February 1st, but spots fill up fast!
3. Work Permits – Ms. Severo will be unexpectedly away for the final two weeks of this semester. If you want to get a Work Permit for winter break, your application form must be completed and brought to Mrs. Garcia or Mrs. Duran in the south campus administration office before Wednesday, December 12 at 2:30pm. After that time you will not be able to get a Work Permit for the break. In January, Work Permits will return to Ms. Severo in the Student Center. Be sure to check the Work Permit Requirements to make sure you qualify.

COUNSELING

1. Second Semester Schedules: Are now viewable through your Aeries.net account. Please see your counselor on or before Friday, 12/7, if you need to make an adjustment to your schedule. Classes have been balanced to meet teacher contract requirements thus we are unable to accommodate order or teacher change requests.
2. **Attention Juniors and Seniors:** This is a reminder that registration for Spring Dual Enrollment Courses must be completed by **Friday, December 7th**. These courses earn you FREE transferable college credit as well as high school elective credit, and if you are a senior who enrolls in a dual enrollment class, you may be eligible to have a four-period class day. You must first complete an online application to Crafton Hills College, complete the Student Information Form through your RUSD Google account, and complete and turn-in the High School Dual Enrollment Request Form. See your high school counselor for more information, or visit www.redlandsusd.net/collegeandcareer and click on the CHC Dual Enrollment link on the left hand side of the page. Again, all registration is due no later than **December 7th**.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Must be at least 13 years old, currently enrolled in 8th-12th grade, and a legal resident of the US.
Student must create a free Circkled In account at www.circkledin.com and submit a response to the question: "If you could give one gift to the world, what would it be?". Cash scholarship can be applied to any educational need including high school. No minimum GPA requirement. Deadline is December 31st, 2018.
