COUNSELING

1. Second Semester Schedules: Are now viewable through your Aeries.net account. Please see your counselor on or before Friday, 12/7, if you need to make an adjustment to your schedule. Classes have been balanced to meet teacher contract requirements thus we are unable to accommodate order or teacher change requests.
2. **Attention Juniors and Seniors:** This is a reminder that registration for Spring Dual Enrollment Courses must be completed by **Friday, December 7th**. These courses earn you FREE transferable college credit as well as high school elective credit, and if you are a senior who enrolls in a dual enrollment class, you may be eligible to have a four-period class day. You must first complete an online application to Crafton Hills College, complete the Student Information Form through your RUSD Google account, and complete and turn-in the High School Dual Enrollment Request Form. See your high school counselor for more information, or visit www.redlandsusd.net/collegeandcareer and click on the CHC Dual Enrollment link on the left hand side of the page. Again, all registration is due no later than **December 7th**.

3. **2nd Semester Schedule Distribution:** When you return to RHS on Monday, Jan. 7, 2019, you should report directly to your 1st Period class *from 1st semester* to pick up a copy of your new, 2nd semester schedule. The schedule pick-up window will be from 7:25-7:35am; once you have picked up your new schedule, you should then report directly to your new 2nd semester, 1st Period class (ideally by 7:40am). Although 1st Period will be 10-15 minutes shorter due to schedule distribution, we will operate on a regular time schedule that day. Students who do not have a 1st Period, should see Ms. Tracy Meyers in the Admin building for their schedule. Enjoy your time off and we will see you in 2019!
