GENERAL

SENIORS

1. **Attention all seniors that will be attending Grad Nite!** Disney has announced they will open the new Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge for Grad Nite. In order to visit Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge, you **MUST** have a Disney Account and you **MUST** make a reservation! There is no cost to make a reservation but reservations are subject to availability. You should not make your reservation later than 7:00PM because all students must exit Disneyland by 8:00PM and remain in CA Adventure for the remainder of the evening. The first day to book your reservation is May 2nd at 10:00AM. Remember, you must have a Disney Account to register for a reservation so be sure to create one before registration opens at 10:00AM on May 2nd. 2. Seniors, you've worked hard to earn your diploma! Let's make sure you can pick up your diploma after graduation. If you owe any fees, books or uniforms to RHS or fees to a previous school, your transcripts AND diploma will be held until your account is cleared. If you are not sure your account is cleared, stop by the records office and ask. Juniors, Sophomores and Freshman can check their account to. Keep on top of your account and make sure you clear it every year. Don't wait until the last day of your senior year!
3. College-bound Seniors: **BEFORE** graduation you **MUST** submit a final transcript request to the south campus information desk for the college you plan to attend. Your final transcript is sent by the records office only if YOU request that it be sent. Be sure to mark your request **FINAL**. All final transcript requests will be mailed by the records office the week after final grades are posted.

STUDENT CENTER

1. Sophomores and Juniors: Sign up now for a Jumpstart2College presentation! Learn about the Dual Enrollment Partnership with Crafton Hills Colleges, which provides students the opportunity to take college courses on RUSD high school campuses for FREE. All courses are transferable to CCCs, UCs, and CSUs, and earn students both college credit and high school elective credit. (ART 175, however, also counts toward a student's high school graduation fine arts requirement because it is taught by an RUSD high school art teacher). Dual Enrollment Presentation will take place: Thursday, 5/9 during Period 5 in the Student Center. Sign up with Ms. Severo to get a pass to attend.
2. Any student under 18 years of age who has not yet graduated from high school and plans to work for an employer during the summer must have a work permit! Normally, work permits are handled in your high school Student Center through Ms. Severo. The last day she will accept Work Permit Applications will be WEDNESDAY, June 5th, no later than 2:30pm. During the summer (STARTING MONDAY, JUNE 10th), work permits can be obtained through the South Campus Administration Office at Redlands High School. **NO WORK PERMITS ARE ISSUED THE THREE WEEKS DIRECTLY FOLLOWING RUSD SUMMER SCHOOL.** Students will have to wait until school starts to submit a Work Permit Application. Work Permit Applications are available in the Student Center and at the Information Desk in the south campus Administration Office. During the summer they will be available in the south campus Administration Office ONLY.

To obtain a valid work permit, students must meet the following requirements:

1. The student must have been offered a job.
2. The student, parent, and employer must fully complete the Request for a Work Permit (B1-1) form (green paper application).
3. The student must meet the minimum academic and attendance requirements necessary to receive the work permit.
