SCHOLARSHIPS

1. # 2 The Educator STEPCon committee is looking for engaging student speakers for its annual Educator Conference this coming October. Towards that end, the Science Technology and Education Partnership (STEP) is proud to announce the STEP Student STEM Keynote Scholarship. This is a \$500 bonded scholarship for two students, one student from Riverside County and the other from San Bernardino County. The application requires students to share their STEM education journey and how it has greatly impacted their lives.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

1. Students must be available to share the impact of STEM Education on their lives in a 10-minute keynote speech at the Educator STEPCon 2019 on Tuesday, October 1, 2019.

2. Students must submit an online application.

3. Students must be in the 11th or 12th grade at a public high school in Riverside or San Bernardino County.

Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (in lieu of the GPA minimum requirement, students may submit a signed letter of support from a STEM teacher).
