COUNSELING

1. Seniors attending Crafton Hills College this Fall

The Crafton Hills College SOAR program starts on Tuesday, February 25 with a MANDATORY meeting after school in Grace Mullen Auditorium. Students who participate in SOAR get priority registration; meaning you will get the classes you want when you start school next fall. SOAR opens up other opportunities and is REQUIRED for the Free College Promise! Here's how to SOAR:

1. **Sign-up for SOAR by February 24th** by completing the form at this link: http://bit.ly/SOAR_2020
2. **Apply to Crafton Hills College for Fall 2020** - RHS counselors and Student Center personnel can help you with this.
3. **Complete the Online Orientation** - Log into Web Advisor once you get your Crafton ID to complete this 30 minute orientation.
4. **Assessment** - This will be offered through SOAR. It provides placement in Math and English.
5. **Advising** - You will meet with a Crafton Counselor and complete an initial student educational plan.
6. **Registration** - Students who complete the SOAR Program get two steps higher priority registration. Don't forget to complete your **FAFSA** and put Crafton Hills College on your list of colleges. The deadline to apply is March 2, 2020.

SCHOLARSHIPS

1. **#59 Riverside Japanese American Citizens League Scholarship** for high school students who are planning to attend college this fall. Scholarships are open to JACL members, their dependents, or any American of Japanese ancestry. Applicants do not have to be members of Riverside JACL. 2. **#60 Italian Catholic Federation (I.C.F.) Scholarship.** Applicants must be of the Roman Catholic Faith, have a total GPA 3.2 for 3 ½ years. Interested students go to www.icf.org and download the application. Deadline to apply is March 15, 2020.
3. **# 61 Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund TASF.** The Taiwanese American Scholarship Fund is focused on helping economically-challenged Taiwanese American youth fulfill their dreams of obtaining higher education. This scholarship is open to high school seniors planning to attend college in the fall of 2020. Deadline to apply is Wednesday March 25, 2020. Must be a US citizen or a US permanent resident and direct blood descendant of a Taiwanese citizen, have a minimum GPA of 3.0, have a household income at or below the Federal State Low income level. 4. **#62 Shine A Light Scholarship for Foster youth.** All San Bernardino County foster youth who are graduating high school this year, former foster youth currently enrolled in a college or accredited vocational school, extended foster care youth. An 500-600 word essay will be required, along with a nomination form. Deadline is February 14, 2020.
