GENERAL

1. If you are planning to attend Genesis, please be aware of the following things:
 1. There are NO Guest Passes available for this dance.
 2. FORMS: If you did not turn in the 2019-2020 dance contract, you will not be able to purchase Genesis tickets until that form is completed. You must ALSO have your Genesis Permission Slip signed by you and your parent This is different than your Dance Contract. Both forms are available online and in the Student Center and both forms should be turned into the Finance Office when you purchase your tickets.
 3. If you aren't sure if you turned in your Dance Contract you can check the list at the Information/Switchboard in the South Campus Office.
 4. All Genesis tickets are non-refundable. We will not be able to give you your money back if you do not attend. Please make sure that you can go before you purchase!
 5. Attendance. If you wish to attend Genesis, please be aware that you must meet the requirements of the RHS Dance Attendance Policy. Your 2nd Semester Attendance will be checked before all Genesis tickets are purchased. If you have questions about your attendance, or would like to check your eligibility, see Mrs. Beal in the Student Center.
 6. ID Cards: Current ID Cards must be presented for ALL transactions@ the Finance Office windows. This includes Genesis Tickets. If you have lost your ID card, you may purchase a replacement for \$5.00 at the Finance Office. Plan ahead, as it may take 24 hours to get a new ID card.

COUNSELING

1. **Seniors attending Crafton Hills College this Fall**

The Crafton Hills College SOAR program starts on Tuesday, February 25 with a MANDATORY meeting after school in Grace Mullen Auditorium. Students who participate in SOAR get priority registration; meaning you will get the classes you want when you start school next fall. SOAR opens up other opportunities and is REQUIRED for the Free College Promise! Here's how to SOAR:

1. **Sign-up for SOAR by February 24th** by completing the form at this link: http://bit.ly/SOAR_2020
 2. **Apply to Crafton Hills College for Fall 2020** - RHS counselors and Student Center personnel can help you with this.
 3. **Complete the Online Orientation** - Log into Web Advisor once you get your Crafton ID to complete this 30 minute orientation.
 4. **Assessment** - This will be offered through SOAR. It provides placement in Math and English.
 5. **Advising** - You will meet with a Crafton Counselor and complete an initial student educational plan.
 6. **Registration** - Students who complete the SOAR Program get two steps higher priority registration. Don't forget to complete your **FAFSA** and put Crafton Hills College on your list of colleges. The deadline to apply is March 2, 2020.
