**Attention all 8<sup>th</sup> graders:** In order to participate in high school sports in the 2019-2020 school year, all athletes must register online to be cleared **before** attending any tryouts or practices-**this includes all workouts during the summer of 2019**. Redlands Unified School District is now using a secure registration platform, AthleticClearance.com that provides our families with a safe, easy, and user-friendly way to register for high school athletics! Specific athletic clearance directions are also listed on the athletic website for RHS, REVHS and CVHS and requires you to have a physical exam completed by a doctor as part of the clearance process. It is your responsibility to be aware of when your desired sport starts practicing and this information can be found on each school's website beginning May 1, 2019.
