TESTING INFORMATION

HIGH SCHOOL EXIT EXAM

State law no longer mandates administration of district proficiency tests for graduation. However, students are required to pass the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) as a part of Federal Law, No Child Left Behind. The exam will be given multiple times during each school year to 10th, 11th and 12th grade students. The testing dates are as follows:

END OF COURSE EXAMS

End of course exams are teacher developed tests designed to measure student comprehension of state subject standards. Teachers in departments with state standards and end of course exams in place, will administer the test during the final exam schedule each semester. The final exams will be administered in December and June with specific times listed in the daily bulletin. Final Exam dates are as follows:

2nd Semester Finals: June 2-4
